## IMPORTANT DATES 2023

## APRIL

April 5<sup>th</sup> – 13<sup>th</sup> – Passover (The major Jewish spring festival which commemorates the liberation of the Israelites from Egyptian slavery, lasting seven or eight days from the 15<sup>th</sup> of Nisan.)

April 9<sup>th</sup> – Easter (A Christian festival and cultural holiday commemorating the resurrection of Jesus from the dead.)

April 12<sup>th</sup> – May 12<sup>th</sup> – Ramadan (The ninth month of the Islamic calendar, observed by Muslims worldwide as a month of fasting, prayer, reflection and community. A commemoration of Muhammad's first revelation.)

April 23<sup>rd</sup> – Gathering of Nations (The largest pow-wow in the U.S. and North America. Held annually in April in Albuquerque, New Mexico and attended by over 565 tribes.)

April 24<sup>th</sup> – Armenian Martyrs' Day (Held annually to commemorate the victims of the Armenian genocide off 1915.)

Armenian History Month is recognized annually each **April** to pay tribute to the Armenian community in a celebration of history and culture and in recognition of the community's struggle for inclusion and equity.
